

MARLON NOBLE — REPORT BY ROBERT COCK, QC

703. Hon ALISON XAMON to the minister representing the Minister for Corrective Services:

I refer to the answer to my question without notice on 30 August 2011.

- (1) Will the minister please table the business improvement review?
- (2) If no to (1), why not?
- (3) As a result of the findings of the inquiry by Mr Robert Cock, QC, have any staff at Greenough Regional Prison been or will be subject to disciplinary action?
- (4) If no to (3), why not?

Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question.

- (1) No.
- (2) The minister commissioned a separate inquiry, conducted by Mr Robert Cock, which has already been tabled in Parliament. In addition, Mr Cock has paid due notice to the internal inquiry from the Department of Corrective Services prior to him compiling his own report.
- (3) No.
- (4) Mr Cock made no recommendations for disciplinary action to be taken. The focus of Mr Cock's inquiry was about fixing the problem and taking remedial action to mitigate against a similar incident happening again, and not about allocating blame.
