

INFRASTRUCTURE WESTERN AUSTRALIA — SUBMISSIONS

505. Hon PETER COLLIER to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

I refer to the creation of Infrastructure Western Australia and the public submissions process.

- (1) How many submissions were submitted by government agencies, statutory authorities and government trading enterprises?
- (2) Will the Premier provide a list of the government agencies, statutory authorities and government trading enterprises that provided a submission; and, if not, why not?
- (3) Will the minister table those submissions; and, if not, why not?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1) Sixteen state agencies, statutory authorities and government trading enterprises made submissions.
- (2) The state government agencies that provided submissions were: the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions; the Department of Education; the Department of Fire and Emergency Services; the Department of Health; the Department of Finance; the Department of Jobs, Tourism, Science and Innovation; the Department of Justice; the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries; the Department of Transport; the Office of the Government Architect; and the WA Police Force.
The state government trading enterprises that provided submissions were: Horizon Power, Synergy, Water Corporation and Western Power.
The state government statutory authority that provided a submission was the Peel Development Commission.
