

MINISTERS OF THE CROWN — AIR CHARTER SERVICES

3355. Mr M. McGowan to the Minister representing the Attorney General; Minister for Commerce:

I refer to the Minister's use of ministerial air-charter services and ask, for the period since 16 August 2014, and ask:

- (a) on what date or dates did the Minister use a ministerial air-charter service;
- (b) what was the destination or destinations for each use of a ministerial air-charter service;
- (c) what are the names of all persons on the manifest for each trip undertaken by the Minister using a ministerial air-charter service; and
- (d) what, if any, was the additional cost associated with each use of a ministerial air-charter service outside the primary contract fee paid by the State?

Mrs L.M. Harvey replied:

- (a)–(d) The Attorney General; Minister for Commerce has not chartered the use of the Ministerial Air Charter Service between the period 16 August 2014 and 17 February 2015.
