

PRISONS — CAPACITY

441. Mr P. PAPALIA to the Minister for Corrective Services:

As a supplementary question, does that not mean that apart from Derby prison, which was Labor's project, and work camps and double-bunking, there will be no increase to capacity until 2013?

Mr C.C. PORTER replied:

The increase in capacity is as follows: Acacia Prison will have 387 beds; Derby will have 150 beds; Eastern Goldfields Regional Prison will have 350 beds —

Mr P. Papalia: That is not until 2013.

Mr C.C. PORTER: Hold on a second!

Warburton work camp will have 30 beds; wheatbelt work camp will have 20 beds; Wyndham work camp will have 40 beds; and the young offenders' prison will have 80 beds. The young offenders' prison will be finished well before the date that the member has said. A great deal of the construction will be finished before 2013.
