

**OFF-ROAD MOTORCYCLES — PUBLIC DISTURBANCE**

*Petition*

**MR P. PAPALIA (Peel)** [3.03 pm]: I have a petition containing 39 signatures and certified by the Clerk as conforming with the requirements of standing orders. It states —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in a Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned, say,

That most week nights and weekends, we have to put up with the constant noise and dust from off-road motorbikes screaming around not only on the bush surrounding Port Kennedy Golf course, but on the roads as well. One person has had a house brick thrown through the bedroom window at 2:00 AM. I have had the threat to burn my house down. This conduct breaches our Human right of peaceful occupation of the home. Other acts of intimidation have been outlined to our local Member.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly

That all motor bikes, quads etc, that are not registered for on road use, to have to register as off-road use. The owner would have to supply a written description of bike, Quad etc, plus photo, they would then sign a form which lists the only area's that can legally be used. A nominal fee charged to cover costs.

First offence, Police confiscate bike for 3 months.

Second offence confiscate Bike, quad, and sell to cover costs, fine Parents for condoning behaviour.
