2007. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

With regard to the Marine Parks and Reserves Authority (MPRA), I ask:

- (a) what support will the Authority receive from the Department of Parks and Wildlife (DPaW) in 2013–2014;
- (b) how many full-time equivalents are directly employed by the MPRA; and
- (c) how many full-time equivalents are employed by DPaW to service the needs of the MPRA?
