

NOISE ABATEMENT — ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT REGULATION REVIEW

Petition

MR C.J. TALLENTIRE (Gosnells) [9.01 am]: I have a petition that bears 515 signatures concerning the doof-doof noise or subsonic vibration problem that is blighting our suburbs. It reads —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned, say;

- too many people are having the peace of their homes disturbed by sub-sonic vibration from powerful bass loudspeakers:
- now we ask that the Legislative Assembly calls upon the State Government to review the effectiveness of the regulations under the Environmental Protection Act to enable proper measurement of disturbance from low-frequency bass units and to enable Local Government and Police to investigate reports of low-frequency disturbances:
