2241. Hon Amber-Jade Sanderson to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Water:

For each of the years 2011–12, 2012–13, 2013–14 and 2014 to date, I ask:

- (a) how many Water Corporation staff took voluntary redundancy;
- (b) how many Water Corporation staff have been made redundant involuntarily;
- (c) how many full time equivalents were filled by temporary contracts other than for the purpose of covering permanent staff on paid leave, workers' compensation or maternity leave; and
- (d) how many permanent positions were abolished?

Hon Ken Baston replied:

- (b) 2011–2012; 2012–2013; 2013–14 0

- (c) The Full Time Employees (FTE) numbers provided below reflect temporary staff paid via the Payroll. The Water Corporation's systems do not readily enable them to breakdown the numbers associated with each type of employment status.

2013–2014 77
1 July 2014 to 31 December 2014 37
- (d) The Water Corporation adjusts its workforce to meet business needs, and therefore, positions are created and abolished as required. The answers given below therefore reflect the net change in permanent positions for each of the financial years.
