

DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING — VACANT PROPERTIES — THORNLIE AND GOSNELLS

2930. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Housing:

Are there any vacant properties owned by the Department of Housing in each of the suburbs of Thornlie and Gosnells which are currently untenanted, and if so:

- (a) what are the addresses of these properties;
- (b) when was the last time each property was tenanted;
- (c) what is the reason for each vacancy; and
- (d) does the Department intend to sell any of these properties before 2017, and if so, which ones?

Mr W.R. Marmion replied:

The Department of Housing advises:

- (a) As at 31 August 2014, there were six vacant properties in Thornlie and eight in Gosnells. Nine of these properties have since been occupied.
