

CORRIGIN ROADS — WORKS PLANNED

4486. Hon Ken Travers to the Minister for Finance representing the Minister for Transport
- (1) What road works are planned from Corrigin to —
    - (a) Bendering;
    - (b) Kondinin; and
    - (c) Kulin?
  - (2) When will works commence?
  - (3) What is the cost of these works?
  - (4) If no works are planned for (1), how are these roads expected to cope with increased traffic due to the closure of Tier 3 rail lines?

Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:

Main Roads WA advises:

- (1)
  - (a) The preferred route between Corrigin and Bendering would be via the Brookton Highway and the Kondinin–Narembeen Road. Planned road improvements on Brookton Highway between Corrigin and the Kondinin–Narembeen Road intersection have been completed.
  - (b) Principally the necessary major works have been completed between Corrigin and Kondinin.
  - (c) As above, road improvements on Brookton Highway between Corrigin and the Gorge Rock–Lake Grace Road intersection have been completed.
