

“PUBLIC TRANSPORT FOR PERTH IN 2031” — MODELLING

581. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the minister representing the Minister for Transport:

I refer to the minister's answer to question without notice 532, asked last Tuesday.

- (1) What was the basis for the estimated population of 110 000?
- (2) Which suburbs were included in the catchment area to produce this estimation?
- (3) Will the minister table the source documents or information on which this estimation was based; and, if not, why not?
- (4) Will the minister table the Public Transport Authority report “Outer North-Eastern Corridor Public Transport Strategy–Pre-Feasibility Study” of October 2009; and, if not, why not?

- (1) A draft of “Directions 2031”.
- (2) The forecast population is for all areas north of Butler, in the City of Wanneroo, to the west of Wanneroo Road.
- (3) The source documents are publicly available from the Western Australian Planning Commission.
- (4) No. Cabinet has yet to decide on aspects of the broader plan to which this report is linked.
