

SPORT AND RECREATION — COLLIE MINEWORKERS MEMORIAL POOL

1715. Hon Jim Chown to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Sport and Recreation:

I refer to the McGowan Government's commitment of \$2 million towards a new 25-metre indoor pool and clubrooms at the Collie Mine Workers Memorial Olympic Pool:

- (a) what is the current status of this project;
- (b) has the financial assistance agreement been completed;
- (c) what is the total cost of the project and who will fund the remainder of the cost of the construction;
- (d) when will the pool be constructed; and
- (e) what are the annual maintenance costs and who will fund these costs?

Hon Sue Ellery replied:

- (a) The project is in the planning stage. Community consultation is currently underway.
- (b) A Financial Assistance Agreement for \$150,000 for planning has been executed between the State and the Shire of Collie.
- (c)–(e) To be determined as part of the planning. The Shire of Collie will be required to fund maintenance.
