23. Mrs M.H. ROBERTS to the Minister for Police:

I have a supplementary question. What price does the minister, as Minister for Road Safety, put on keeping intoxicated people out of their cars and off the roads? I note that the minister did not answer my previous question on what advice she received from her agencies.

Mrs L.M. HARVEY replied:

Everybody in Western Australia understands and knows that this government is committed to reducing alcohol-related harm in the community, particularly that caused by drink-drivers. I have just gone into great detail to explain one of the government's key initiatives in this space. I regularly consult with my agencies on a range of issues. Specifically on the proposed removal of the late-night train service, I have not received specific advice on that matter from my agencies.
