Question: Dr M.D. Nahan asked: What does the Fremantle Port Authority understand to be the cost of shipping a 20-foot container from the port to the Kewdale container terminal?

Answer: Fremantle Ports is unable to respond as these costs are not within its purview and it does not capture this information.

The Department of Transport has advised that indicative trucking costs for a standard return trip to Kewdale are in the order of \$360–\$420 per twenty-foot equivalent unit (ex. GST). The actual cost per unit depends on a range of factors, including total volume of the order, time of year, etc.

Question: Mrs L.M. Harvey asked: In last year's budget there was provision in the forward estimates for a replacement workshop and fire station at Victoria Quay. Why is it no longer required?

Answer: The replacement workshop and fire station asset investment project is not required within the 2019–20 Budget and forward estimates period as timing of the project has been deferred to a period post completion of the Fremantle Waterfront Implementation Plan project due to inter-dependencies of the projects.
