

ROCK FISHING —MANDATORY LIFE JACKETS

**1231. Hon COLIN HOLT to the minister representing the Minister for Fisheries:**

I refer to the trial of the mandatory wearing of life jackets for anglers at rock fishing black spots, as announced by the Premier on 29 April 2018.

- (1) Who are the members of the trial reference group and what organisations do they represent?
- (2) Will legislation be required to implement the trial; and, if so, what act or acts will need to be amended?
- (3) If legislation is not required, how will the trial be legally enforced?

**Hon ALANNAH MacTIERNAN replied:**

I thank the member for the question. The following information has been provided to me by the Minister for Fisheries.

- (1) Trial reference group membership: the Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development; the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation and Attractions; the Department of Fire and Emergency Services, representing volunteer rescue groups; the City of Albany; and Recfishwest, the peak body representing recreational fishers.
- (2) Yes. Regulations will be drafted under the Conservation and Land Management Act 1984.
