

ROCKINGHAM–MANDURAH — ANTISOCIAL, DANGEROUS AND CRIMINAL BEHAVIOUR

Petition

MR P. PAPALIA (Warnbro) [3.01 pm]: The third petition is signed by 38 petitioners. It is titled “Petition Against Violent and Anti-social Behaviour between Rockingham and Mandurah” and reads as follows —

To the Honourable Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, say that the level of anti-social, dangerous and criminal behaviour in the area between Rockingham and Mandurah has escalated to such an extent that it is impacting on the lives of local residents, many of whom are becoming fearful of leaving their homes.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly to call upon the Barnett Government to build a Police Station between Rockingham and Mandurah and create tougher laws, to address the concerns of the local community.
