

ROAD TRAFFIC (VEHICLES) (TAXING) BILL 2007

Receipt and First Reading

Bill received from the Assembly; and, on motion by **Hon Adele Farina (Parliamentary Secretary)**, read a first time.

Second Reading

HON ADELE FARINA (South West — Parliamentary Secretary) [5.06 pm]: I move —

That the bill be now read a second time.

This is one of a suite of five bills to facilitate the introduction of the Road Transport Reform (Compliance and Enforcement) Bill national reforms and to realign Western Australia's road traffic legislation based on administrative and functional responsibilities. This bill provides the legal mechanism for vehicle licence fees to be imposed in excess of the administrative costs associated with granting vehicle licences. These additional charges go towards the provisions of road infrastructure—roads, bridges etc—for the use of vehicles in Western Australia.

I commend the bill to the house.
