830. Mr A. Krsticevic to the minister representing the Minister for Education and Training:

For each department, agency and government trading enterprise within the Minister's portfolio of responsibilities, can the Minister please advise how much money is allocated in the agency's budget for language service delivery, in the following financial years:

- (a) 2012/13;
- (b) 2013/14;
- (c) 2014/15;
- (d) 2015/16; and
- (e) 2016/17?

Mr P. Papalia replied:

The Department of Education is committed, through the Western Australian Government's Language Services Policy (the Policy), to provide translating and interpreting language services to assist culturally and linguistically diverse (CaLD) members of the community gain access to school education services. The Department's compliance with the Policy ensures that the fundamental public sector values associated with the delivery of fair and equitable services and the achievement of substantive equality are addressed through the use of interpreting and translating services.

Expenditure each year varies due to changes in demand for specific services from schools and the system.
