

TECHNICAL AND FURTHER EDUCATION — ENROLMENTS

4091. Mr W.J. Johnston to the Minister for Training and Workforce Development:

I refer to your statement in the House on 12 May 2015 that there has been a 9% increase in enrolments in priority courses, and I ask:

- (a) what are these “priority courses;
- (b) which campuses are these courses offered; and
- (c) how many students are enrolled in each course at each campus in the following years:
 - (i) 2008;
 - (ii) 2009;
 - (iii) 2010;
 - (iv) 2011;
 - (v) 2012;
 - (vi) 2013;
 - (vii) 2014; and
 - (viii) 2015?

Mrs L.M. Harvey replied:

- (a) The reference to a 9 per cent increase relates to enrolments in broad priority training courses as defined in 2014. In this context priority courses include:
 - all apprenticeships and traineeships;
 - priority industry qualifications as listed in 2014;
 - two priority foundation skills courses - the Course in Applied Vocational Study Skills (CAVSS) and the Course in Underpinning Skills for Industry Qualifications (USIQ); and
 - other eligible foundation skills training and equity courses as listed in 2014.
