

FOREST MANAGEMENT PLAN 2014–2023 — FAUNA PROVISIONS

2002. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

With regard to the Conservation Commission, I ask, does the proposed Forest Management Plan 2014–2023 propose to make the fauna provisions of the *Western Australia Wildlife Conservation Act* apply to state government agencies and their contractors, and if not, why not?

Mr A.P. Jacob replied:

The Forest Management Plan 2014–2023 was prepared to account for relevant provisions of the *Wildlife Conservation Act 1950*. It should be noted that the plan cannot enforce the fauna provisions of the *Wildlife Conservation Act 1950* because the act has primacy over the plan.
