

FIONA STANLEY HOSPITAL — SERCO CONTRACT

**590. Hon HELEN BULLOCK to the minister representing the Minister for Health:**

I refer to the privatisation of services at Fiona Stanley Hospital and the confirmed contract with Serco.

- (1) Will the minister table the public–private comparator and other documents that support the proposed \$500 million worth of savings; and, if not, why not?
- (2) Will the minister table the risk analysis report that would have been completed to support the contract process; and, if not, why not?
- (3) If no to (1) and (2), will the minister give written notice to both houses of Parliament and to the Auditor General, as required by section 82 of the Financial Management Act 2006?

**Hon HELEN MORTON replied:**

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1)–(2) No. This information contains commercially sensitive information that would place the state at a disadvantage and adversely affect the state’s interests in any future contract discussions.
- (3) Yes.
