**90. Hon LINDA SAVAGE to the minister representing the Minister for Health:**

- (1) What is the government's current budget allocation for the new Midland hospital?
- (2) What are the current projections for the year-to-year cashflowing of this budget?
- (3) What advice has the minister given to the federal government on the construction timetable of this hospital?
- (4) Will the federal government still be providing \$180 million towards the construction of this hospital, and will this be matched by the state government?
- (5) Is the state government proposing that some of its share of the capital funding will be paid by private contribution?

**Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:**

I thank the member for some notice of this question and provide the following answer —

- (1) The government's current budget allocation for the Midland Health Campus development is \$360.2 million, comprising equal funds from state and commonwealth governments.
- (2) Current projections for year-to-year cashflow are shown in table 2 below. These projections are based on a design, build, finance and operate procurement method.
- (3) The minister has advised the commonwealth that MHC will be completed by mid-2015.
- (4) Yes.
- (5) No. Under the proposed DBFO model, capital funding will revert to a recurrent cashflow. The private sector will finance upfront design and construction costs.

I seek leave to table the table and have it incorporated into *Hansard*.
