

PUBLIC HOUSING IN SUBIACO AREA — ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR COMPLAINTS

913. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Housing and Works

- (1) Relative to the total number of Department of Housing rental properties in the suburbs of Daglish, Subiaco and Jolimont, what is the percentage of the number of tenancies that have been the subject of a complaint by neighbours because of anti-social behaviour or alleged criminal behaviour?
- (2) Relative to the total number of Department of Housing rental properties in the suburbs of Daglish, Subiaco and Jolimont, what is the percentage of the number of tenancies that could be managed by the Antisocial Behaviour Intervention Team because of reports of anti-social behaviour or alleged criminal behaviour?
- (3) Are complaints of anti-social behaviour or alleged criminal behaviour against Department of Housing rental tenancies in the suburbs Gosnells, Thornlie and Huntingdale higher than the complaints of anti-social behaviour or alleged criminal behaviour against Department of Housing rental tenancies in Daglish, Subiaco and Jolimont?

Mr T.R. BUSWELL replied:

- (1)-(3) Tenancy-based complaints are treated individually and are not maintained as a central database. Consequently, comparisons within and between suburbs are not possible.

The trial Antisocial Behaviour Intervention Team only commenced operation last month and is currently working with eight tenancies, none of which involve the suburbs mentioned.
