

HOUSING — DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOUR MANAGEMENT STRATEGY

1235. Hon Lynn MacLaren to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Housing:

- (1) Of all people in Western Australia that have been evicted due to the Disruptive Behaviour Management Strategy since its inception, what proportion are Aboriginal people?
- (2) What ratio of evictions are of households with absent male parents or guardians?
- (3) What ratio of evictions are of households with parents or guardians being treated for substance abuse and comorbidities?

Hon Ken Baston replied:

The Department of Housing advises:

- (1) From 1 July 2011 to 31 May 2014, 188 tenancies were terminated under the Disruptive Behaviour Management Strategy. Based on self-identification by the tenant, 66% of these tenancies had Aboriginal people in the household.
- (2)–(3) The Department of Housing does not keep information that would enable it to provide answers to these parts of the question.
