

PARKING INFRINGEMENT TICKET VALIDITY — PUBLIC TRANSPORT AUTHORITY

759. Hon KEN TRAVERS to the minister representing the Minister for Transport:

- (1) Was the Public Transport Authority aware of concerns about the validity of its parking infringement tickets prior to September 2011?
- (2) If yes, when did the PTA first become aware and what action did it take?
- (3) Has a parking infringement ticket issued by the PTA ever been challenged on the grounds that it was invalid because it referred to by-law 80 or did not comply with schedule 2 of the regulations?
- (4) If yes, how many tickets have been challenged?
- (5) Has any of these tickets been cancelled and, if so, why?
- (6) Has the PTA ever sought legal advice regarding the validity of its parking infringement tickets; and, if yes, when?
