

DEPARTMENT OF THE PREMIER AND CABINET — REMUNERATION

1055. Hon PETER COLLIER to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

In the Department of the Premier and Cabinet, what was the base salary, other entitlements and total remuneration for 2017 and 2018 for —

- (a) the director general, Darren Foster; and
- (b) all members of the executive?

The Premier's office sought clarification for that and it is for deputy directors.

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (a) The base salary, as at 16 June 2017, was \$367 070 per annum. The motor vehicle allowance was \$22 650 per annum. The base salary from 18 July 2017 is \$441 406 per annum. The motor vehicle allowance is \$22 650 per annum.

The difference in the base salary for Mr Foster arose from his acting role later changing to his permanent appointment to the role. The base salary upon permanent appointment is the same as that paid to the previous director general, Mr Peter Conran.

- (b) It is noted that in 2016, the department had 11 officers at CEO/non-CEO bands 1 to 4, who were on more than \$200 000 per annum. In 2017, under Mr Foster's management, the department had five officers, including the director general. Details of the executive officers follow.

For the years 2017 and 2018, the base salary for deputy director general Malcolm Bradshaw is \$307 301 per annum. His motor vehicle allowance is \$22 650 per annum.

For the years 2017 and 2018, the base salary for deputy director general Michelle Andrews is \$307 301 per annum. Her motor vehicle allowance is \$22 650 per annum.

For the years 2017 and 2018, the base salary for executive director Robert Kennedy is \$227 819 per annum. His motor vehicle allowance is \$20 300 per annum.
