

LOGGING CONTRACTORS — MOWEN 1 AND 2

1460. Hon Lynn MacLaren to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Forestry:
- (1) Which falling and hauling contractors are contracted to log and transport timber from:
    - (a) Mowen 1; and
    - (b) Mowen 2?
  - (2) To which buyers will the logs from Mowen 1 be delivered?
  - (3) To which buyers will the logs from Mowen 2 be delivered?
  - (4) Will the Minister please table the latest coupe maps for:
    - (a) Mowen 1; and
    - (b) Mowen 2?
  - (5) Will the Minister please table a map of the Augusta Margaret River Shire at a scale of 1:50,000 showing:
    - (a) the forests in the conservation reserve system and the forests available for logging;
    - (b) the year of last logging for each forest compartment for all forests available for logging;
    - (c) forest type (i.e. karri, jarrah);
    - (d) location of non-native plantations, showing species and year of planting;
    - (e) major rivers;
    - (f) major roads; and
    - (g) towns?
