

ROYAL COMMISSION INTO INSTITUTIONAL RESPONSES TO CHILD SEXUAL ABUSE —
RECOMMENDATIONS

1330. Hon Alison Xamon to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Child Protection:
- (1) Has the Government's comprehensive response to the recommendations of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse been finalised?
 - (2) If yes to (1), when will it be publicly released?
 - (3) If no to (1), when is it expected to be finalised?
 - (4) Which individuals and organisations were consulted in the development of the response?

Hon Sue Ellery replied:

- (1) The State Government's comprehensive response to the recommendations of the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse (Royal Commission) has been finalised.
- (2) The State Government's response was released on 27th June 2018.
- (3) Not applicable.
- (4) The following agencies were consulted in the development of the Western Australian Government's six-month response:

Department of Communities;
Department of Justice;
Department of Education;
Department of Health;
Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries;
Department of Treasury;
Western Australia Police Force;
Mental Health Commission;
State Records Office;
Ombudsman Western Australia; and
Commissioner for Children and Young People.

Consultation has occurred with all Ministerial Offices and the following offices were provided with a draft Western Australian Government six-month response: Premier; Deputy Premier and Health; Attorney General; Education; Disability Services; Police; Corrective Services; Local Government and Culture and the Arts; Sport and Recreation and Volunteering; Youth.
