

CONSERVATION COMMISSION — CONSERVATION AND LAND MANAGEMENT ACT 1984

1998. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Environment:

With regard to the Conservation Commission, I ask:

- (a) what is the status of the Conservation Commission's intention to amend the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984* to create a statutory duty for the Commission to provide advice to the Minister for Environment, and for its tabling in Parliament; and
- (b) does the Minister support such an amendment?

Mr A.P. Jacob replied:

- (a) Reference to the intention by the Conservation Commission of Western Australia to amend the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984* to create a statutory duty for the Commission to provide advice to the Minister for Environment is assumed to have been extracted from the Conservation Commission of Western Australia's mid-term audit of performance report on the Forest Management Plan 2004–2013.

The Conservation Commission has no current intention to seek amendment to the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984* to create a statutory duty for the Commission to provide advice to the Minister for Environment, and for its tabling in Parliament.
