Question without Notice 868 — Answer Advice

HON COL HOLT (South West — Parliamentary Secretary) [5.05 pm]: I would like to provide an answer to Hon Samantha Rowe's question without notice 868, asked yesterday, which I seek leave to have incorporated into *Hansard*.

The following material was incorporated —

The Housing Authority advises:

- (1) Since 15 June 2016, 210 properties have been inspected to date. These inspections were part of the Stage One "pilot phase" which was completed in August.
 - (2) The properties inspected from the 15 June 2016 to date are located in the South East Metro (50), Wheatbelt (60), Midwest (48) and Great Southern (52) regions.
 - (3) 51 properties were deemed to have defective devices.
 - (4) South East Metro: 8 properties with devices that were deemed defective.
Wheatbelt: 10 properties that were deemed defective.
Midwest: 23 properties that were deemed defective.
Great Southern: 10 properties that were deemed defective.
 - (5) All 51 properties have had their electrical safety devices replaced.
