

COMMISSION OF INQUIRY

520. Hon PETER COLLIER to the Leader of the House representing the Premier:

- (1) How much has been spent on consultants for the commission of inquiry to date?
- (2) How much has been spent on airfares for the commission of inquiry and what were the destinations of that travel?
- (3) How much has been spent on accommodation for the commission of inquiry to date?
- (4) Has a secretariat been established for the commission of inquiry?
- (5) If yes to (4), what is the total staffing profile of the commission of inquiry?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1) The total expenditure on consultants is \$127 609.
- (2) Nil.
- (3) The commission of inquiry occupies accommodation previously used by another government agency. That agency continues to meet the lease costs, so the inquiry does not pay any accommodation expenses.
- (4) Yes, it has.
- (5) The staffing profile of the commission of inquiry is 17.4 full-time equivalent employees, all of whom are public servants.
