

CRIMINAL INJURIES COMPENSATION SCHEME — REVIEW

668. Hon NICK GOIRAN to the Leader of the House representing the Attorney General:

I refer to the Department of Justice's review of the criminal injuries compensation scheme, which was scheduled for completion by October 2018.

- (1) When was the review completed?
- (2) Did the Attorney General receive any documents from the department detailing the outcome of the review?
- (3) If yes to (2), will the Attorney General table those documents?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. I note that this question was asked on 11 June, so the answer is correct as at that date.

- (1)–(2) The review has been completed by the Department of Justice. The Attorney-General's office has received a draft report and it has been referred to the State Solicitor's Office for review.
- (3) The final report will be tabled after the winter recess.
