

PUBLIC HOUSING — GOSNELLS, HUNTINGDALE AND THORNLIE

526. Mr C.J. Tallentire to the Minister for Housing and Works

- (1) How many people were on the Department of Housing's priority waiting list in Gosnells, Huntingdale and Thornlie for:
 - (a) less than four months;
 - (b) four to twelve months;
 - (c) one to two years; and
 - (d) two years or more at 30 December 2008?
- (2) What was the total number of people on the Department of Housing priority waiting list in Gosnells, Huntingdale and Thornlie at 30 December 2008?
- (3) How many people were on the Department of Housing standard waiting list (wait-turn) in Gosnells, Huntingdale and Thornlie for:
 - (a) less than four months;
 - (b) four to twelve months;
 - (c) one to two years;
 - (d) two to three years; and
 - (e) three of years or more at 30 December 2008?
- (4) What was the total number of people on the Department of Housing priority waiting list in Gosnells, Huntingdale and Thornlie at 30 December 2008?

Mr T.R. BUSWELL replied:

- (1) Gosnells and Huntingdale are in the South East Metro preference area which comprises 34 suburbs. Public housing applicants are listed by preference areas not individual suburbs.
Thornlie is in the Southern Districts preference area which comprises 25 suburbs. Public housing applicants are listed by preference areas not individual suburbs.
The below information is provided for preference areas —
 - (a) 27 for South East Metro and 35 for Southern Districts
 - (b) 50 for South East Metro and 76 for Southern Districts
 - (c) 10 for South East Metro and 31 for Southern Districts
 - (d) Nil for South East Metro and Nil for Southern Districts
- (2) 87 for South East Metro and 142 for Southern Districts.
- (3)
 - (a) 89 for South East Metro and 88 for Southern Districts
 - (b) 215 for South East Metro and 178 for Southern Districts
 - (c) 242 for South East Metro and 177 for Southern Districts
 - (d) 138 for South East Metro and 170 for Southern Districts
 - (e) 154 for South East Metro and 236 for Southern Districts
