

SCHOOL FACILITIES — PORT HEDLAND-SOUTH HEDLAND

1203. Hon HELEN BULLOCK to the minister representing the Minister for Education:

- (1) What plans and funding commitments are being put in place to expand new school facilities in Port Hedland and South Hedland?
- (2) What funds have been allocated to replace the ageing South Hedland Primary School?
- (3) What funds have been allocated to enhance the facilities at the Hedland Senior High School?

Hon PETER COLLIER replied:

I thank the member for some notice of this question.

- (1) None.
- (2) The South Hedland Primary School will not be replaced. The school has been approved under the commonwealth Building the Education Revolution initiative for a new early childhood facility valued at \$1.5 million, \$200 000 worth of classroom refurbishments and \$125 000 to be spent on carpeting, painting and improvements to the water supply.
- (3) Hedland Senior High School will receive \$200 000 worth of work under the Building the Education Revolution program. This will be spent on carpeting, door replacement, glazing and resurfacing of some playing services.
