

MURDOCH DRIVE CONNECTION PROJECT

Petition

HON SIMON O'BRIEN (South Metropolitan) [2.03 pm]: I present a petition containing 246 signatures couched in the following terms —

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We the undersigned are opposed to the current plan of the Murdoch Drive Connection project, which reduces access to local roads for the community and provides limited local access to the Murdoch Drive Connection itself. We find the State Government's lack of consultation with the most significantly impacted residential stakeholders for this project to be disappointing.

We therefore ask the Legislative Council to support our desire for the State Government to undertake genuine consultation with the community to develop a plan that will ensure better northbound access to Murdoch Drive and improved access to and from the new Murdoch Drive Connection.
