

STANDING COMMITTEE ON UNIFORM LEGISLATION AND STATUTES REVIEW

Extension of Reporting Time — Motion

Resumed from 17 October on the following motion moved by Hon Michael Mischin (Deputy Leader of the Opposition) —

That the reporting date for the committee inquiry into the National Redress Scheme for Institutional Child Sexual Abuse (Commonwealth Powers) Bill 2018 be extended from 30 October 2018 to 21 November 2018.

HON SUE ELLERY (South Metropolitan — Leader of the House) [5.16 pm]: I indicate that on the basis of discussions behind the Chair with the opposition that it will not put any barriers in the way of this bill progressing before the house rises at the end of 2018, and noting that the reporting back gives us two weeks to deal with this committee report when it comes back to the house, we agree to the extension of time.

HON NICK GOIRAN (South Metropolitan) [5.17 pm]: I am going to say something because the Leader of the House talked about the opposition not putting barriers in the way of the legislation when the matter returns. I have not had time to consider the National Redress Scheme for Institutional Child Sexual Abuse (Commonwealth Powers) Bill 2018 and the Leader of the House knows full well that I have a longstanding interest in this particular matter. I am looking forward to the committee reporting and I give no such undertaking.
