- (3) How many infringements were received at each of the top ten locations in —
 - (a) 2010; and
 - (b) 2011?
- (4) What monitoring of driver behaviour does the Public Transport Authority perform?

 - (a) Wright St near Daly St = 6, Stirling Hwy near Eric St = 5, Walderton Ave near Dallington Cr = 4, Elderberry Dr near McLernon Pl = 4, Erindale Rd near Chelsford Rd = 4, South St near Gracechurch Cr = 4, Hepburn Ave near Lilburne Rd = 3, South Western Hwy near Rails Cr = 3, King Rd near Salween Pl = 3, Read St near Oakwood Cr = 3.
 - (b) Rockingham Rd near Anketell Rd = 11, Kwinana Fwy near Mill Point Rd = 9, Mitchell Fwy near Loftus St = 9, Brockway Rd near Camelia Ave = 9, Gordon Rd near Slade St = 7, Reid Hwy near Mirrabooka Ave = 7, North St near Fourth Ave = 7, Causeway near Herisson Island = 5, Erindale Rd near Chelsford Ave = 5, Mitchell Fwy near Loftus St = 5.
- (4) Driver behaviour monitoring checks include bus service reliability, driving behaviour, driver appearance, customer service, driver cab appearance and passenger information (availability of relevant timetables and brochures on the bus service).
