**HON PETER COLLIER (North Metropolitan — Leader of the House) [2.09 pm]:** — without notice: I move —

That the following procedure shall be followed for debating and voting on the recommendations contained in the forty-fourth report of the Standing Committee on Procedure and Privileges, “A Matter of Privilege Raised by Hon Sue Ellery MLC” —

- (a) each recommendation is to be put as a separate question; and
- (b) pursuant to standing order 22(2), the time limits relating to Committee of the Whole House apply.

**HON SUE ELLERY (South Metropolitan — Leader of the Opposition) [2.10 pm]:** I am sorry to do this but this is what happens when I do not get a copy of the motion beforehand. There was a conversation behind the Chair about the first bit of the motion that each recommendation be dealt with separately, which I am comfortable with.
