The **Department of Transport** advises:

(1-2) The maps on display at the recent media announcement are still subject to potential changes when future traffic modeling information is available. The maps and data will be made publically available in due course.

(3) Yes

(4) It is estimated that the traffic volumes on Riverside Drive will reduce from 34,000 vehicles per day to 14,000. This will result in 14,500 vehicles diverting to the Graham Framer Freeway and the remaining 5,500 will take other routes through the Perth central business district or beyond.
