

PREMIER — REGIONAL MANAGERS FORUMS

190. Hon Alison Xamon to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Community Services:

I refer to the Regional Managers Forums, and I ask:

- (a) does the Premier intend the Regional Managers Forums to continue to operate;
- (b) if no to (a), why not;
- (c) does the Premier intend to review how the Regional Managers Forums operate;
- (d) if no to , why not;
- (e) does the Premier intend to enshrine greater involvement of local community managed services in the Regional Managers Forums;

- (g) if not to (e), why not?
