

KENSINGTON POLICE STATION

223. Mr B.S. Wyatt to the Minister for Police:

I refer to the Kensington Police Station and I ask:

- (a) what has been the full-time equivalent allocation for sworn police officers at this station for each of the years from 2001 to 2013; and
- (b) what is the current full-time equivalent of sworn officers currently stationed at Kensington?

Mrs L.M. Harvey replied:

Western Australia Police advises that due to operational sensitivities, specific information relating to staffing levels of individual police stations is not released. Resources are allocated at a District level and District Superintendents deploy those resources within their District to deliver the best possible policing service to the community. The following are the Full Time Equivalent for the South East Metropolitan District.
