

**RAIL FREIGHT CROSSING — NICHOLSON ROAD, THORNIE**

*Petition*

**MR C.J. TALLENTIRE (Gosnells)** [12.04 pm]: I have a petition from 105 petitioners. It reads —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

*We, the undersigned, say*

1 The at-grade rail/road crossing at the intersection of Nicholson Road, Thornlie and the rail freight line between Midland and Fremantle causes frequent and serious delays for both rail freight and road traffic.

2 The Daddow Road bridge in Forrestfield is currently being constructed to avoid delay at a similar at-grade intersection on the same railway.

*Now we ask the Legislative Assembly*

3 To promote the construction of a Nicholson Road bridge over the railway so that both rail freight and road traffic can proceed without delay through the intersection.

4 To promote the construction of a pedestrian footbridge over the railway at Elliot Place, Thornlie and so avoid train sirens sounding, especially at night.
