

THORNIE SQUARE SHOPPING CENTRE

Petition

MR C.J. TALLENTIRE (Gosnells) [3.26 pm]: I have a petition regarding Thornlie Square shopping centre and its management. It reads —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled:

We, the undersigned, say

We the undersigned Thornlie Square business owners, employees and shoppers are concerned that the management of our shopping centre is failing to provide:

- Transparent acquittal of expenditure made by the centre's management;
- A publicly available register of rents being charged for properties in the centre; *and*
- A Thornlie Square management committee that includes centre tenants prepared to listen and act on business owners' wishes.

Now we ask the Legislative Assembly

- to call on the current Liberal-National Government to stop delaying the introduction of important protection of the rights of small business owners.

The petition has been certified as conforming to the standing orders of the house and it bears 258 signatures. I table the petition.
