\* Banksia Hill Detention Centre is managed by the Department of Justice and not the Department of Education. Wirrabirra Education Support Centre is included with Wirrabirra Primary School.

- (2) Funding is managed centrally and is allocated to address needs in schools as they arise. Schools may elect to manage their own faults and breakdowns up to a maximum of \$5000 per event and receive an allocation from the central maintenance account. Schools may also use part of their one-line budget to undertake maintenance and minor works projects.
