

BEAGLE BAY— SCHOOL BUS SERVICE

**1047. Hon ROBIN CHAPPLE to the minister representing the Minister for Transport:**

I refer to the maintenance of roads on which schoolchildren are transported between the Sacred Heart School at Beagle Bay and Aboriginal communities and outstations in the vicinity.

- (1) How many roads are traversed by the Beagle Bay school bus service contracted by the Public Transport Authority?
- (2) When were these roads identified in (1) last graded?
- (3) Who is responsible for maintaining these roads identified in (1)?
- (4) How much money has been expended by the state government maintaining these roads, road by road, identified in (1) in the last three years?
- (5) What is the current state of the roads used by the Beagle Bay school bus service?

**Hon SIMON O'BRIEN replied:**

I thank the honourable member for notice of this question.

Main Roads WA advises as follows —

- (1) Two roads and two tracks—that is, about which roads are traversed.
- (2)–(5) The roads in question are local roads under the care and management of the Shire of Broome. Any information regarding the condition or maintenance of the roads should be sought from council.
