Following the March 2017 state election, the Department of the Premier and Cabinet has had ongoing and frequent communication with the commonwealth government via letter and email about the National Disability Insurance Scheme. Provision of the information sought by the member would require a significant amount of research and would divert departmental staff away from their normal duties.
