

LAW REFORM COMMISSION — “THE INTERSECTION OF THE FAMILY LAW AND  
CAVEAT SYSTEMS IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA” DISCUSSION PAPER

511. Hon Alison Xamon to the Leader of the House representing the Attorney General:

I refer to the Law Reform Commission’s report into the intersection of the family law and caveat systems in Western Australia, and I ask:

- (a) does the Government support all nine recommendations made by the Law Reform Commission;
- (b) if no to (a), which recommendations are not supported;
- (c) for each recommendation not supported, why is it not supported; and
- (d) for each recommendation supported, when does the Government anticipate the recommendation will be actioned?

**Hon Sue Ellery replied:**

- (a)–(d) The Attorney General is currently consulting with the relevant stakeholders in considering the recommendations.
