

METRONET EAST REDEVELOPMENT AREA — CONSULTATION

573. Hon PETER COLLIER to the minister representing the Minister for Planning:

I refer to the minister's media release of 3 June 2019 titled "New METRONET East Redevelopment Area to help create vibrant centres".

- (1) Did the minister consult with the City of Bayswater, the City of Swan or the City of Kalamunda on her plan to bring the Midland, Bayswater and Forrestfield railway precincts into a redevelopment area known as the Metronet east redevelopment area?
- (2) If yes to (1), with whom and on what dates did the consultation take place?
- (3) If yes to (1), what was the feedback from the consultation?
- (4) Did the minister consult with any other person, organisation or third party regarding the decision; and, if so, with whom and on what dates?
- (5) What was the feedback from this consultation?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

On behalf of the minister representing the Minister for Planning, I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question.

- (1)–(5) In accordance with the Metropolitan Redevelopment Authority Act 2011, the minister wrote to the City of Swan, the City of Bayswater, the City of Kalamunda and the Western Australian Planning Commission on 31 May 2019 requesting their comments on the proposed redevelopment area changes. This process is the same as that followed for the extension of other redevelopment areas such as the central Perth redevelopment area to facilitate the Elizabeth Quay project under the former Liberal–National government. It is expected that comments will be provided within 30 days, in accordance with the Metropolitan Redevelopment Authority Act 2011. Prior to initiating the consultation process, the Minister for Planning spoke to the relevant mayors.
