

FOREST PRODUCTS COMMISSION — MOWEN FOREST

2244. Hon Lynn MacLaren to the Minister for Agriculture and Food representing the Minister for Forestry:
- (1) Further to question on notice No. 1483 of 23 September 2014, what volume of wood does the Forest Products Commission anticipate generating from the planned logging of Mowen 1 and Mowen 2, for each of the following products:
 - (a) firewood;
 - (b) charcoal; and
 - (c) any other products (please specify)?
 - (2) Are there any other products from logging Mowen 1 or Mowen 2 where the Forest Products Commission has not calculated or estimated the volume of wood or product?
 - (3) If yes to (2), what is each product from:
 - (a) Mowen 1; and
 - (b) Mowen 2?

Hon Ken Baston replied:

- (1) (a–(b)) Firewood and charcoal are residue products. Forest Products Commission does not estimate the volumes available.
 - (c) For Mowen 1 the planned volume of first and second grade jarrah logs attributed to this coupe in the annual harvest plans is 3 300 cubic metres. For Mowen 2 the planned volume of first and second grade jarrah logs attributed to this coupe in the annual harvest plans is 4 000 cubic metres.
- (2) Other products will be produced from the coupe if available and required.
