

MOORA RESIDENTIAL COLLEGE — CLOSURE — TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS

183. Hon MARTIN ALDRIDGE to the Minister for Education and Training:

I refer to the case management group established by the Department of Education to assist in the transition of students from Moora Residential College following its closure.

- (1) How many staff will the case management group comprise; and who will lead it?
- (2) What is the estimated cost of the case management group that has been established?
- (3) What is the expected cost of support that will be provided to parents of students?

Hon SUE ELLERY replied:

I thank the honourable member for some notice of the question. In addition to the answer I have signed off, I note that the question is couched as though the case management team has not yet been established; it has been established.

- (1) There are three staff. It is led by the regional executive director, wheatbelt education region.
- (2) There is no additional cost.
- (3) Until the future schooling plans of all students at Moora Residential College are finalised, an expected cost is purely hypothetical.
